AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to allowing the use of rifles for hunting in certain towns in the county of Chautauqua; and providing for the repeal of such provisions upon expiration thereof

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Paragraph a of subdivision 2 of section 11-0907 of the
2 environmental conservation law is amended by adding a new item (j) to
3 read as follows:

14 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall expire and be
15 deemed repealed one year after such effective date or on the same date
16 as paragraph a of subdivision 2 of section 11-0907 of the environmental
17 conservation law expires pursuant to section 13 of chapter 600 of the
18 laws of 1993, as amended, whichever shall occur first.
