AN ACT to amend the Indian law, in relation to limiting the inclusion of certain provisions in Tribal-State compacts

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The Indian law is amended by adding a new section 16 to
2 read as follows:
3 S 16. GAMING COMPACTS SHALL CONFORM TO NEW YORK STATE CONSTITUTION.
4 THE STATE OF NEW YORK SHALL NOT ENTER INTO ANY COMPACT WITH AN INDIAN
5 TRIBE TO PERMIT COMMERCIALIZED CASINO GAMBLING, UNLESS AND UNTIL THE
6 STATE CONSTITUTION IS AMENDED TO PERMIT COMMERCIALIZED CASINO GAMBLING.
7 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
