AN ACT in relation to authorizing and directing the public service commission to study the feasibility of eliminating demand metering

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the public  
2 service commission is hereby authorized and directed to study the feasi-  
3 bility of eliminating demand metering by electric companies. Such study  
4 shall include, but not be limited to:  
5 1. the impact of eliminating demand metering on energy consumption by  
6 electricity customers;  
7 2. the impact of eliminating demand metering on rates charged by elec-  
8 tric companies;  
9 3. the impact of eliminating demand metering on the demand for elec-  
10 tricity by electricity customers;  
11 4. the impact of eliminating demand metering on saving energy; and  
12 5. any other information the commission deems relevant.  
13 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
