AN ACT to amend the general obligations law, in relation to genetically modified organisms

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

9-107. GENETICALLY ENGINEERED OR GENETICALLY MODIFIED ORGANISMS;

1 Section 1. The general obligations law is amended by adding a new 2 section 9-107 to read as follows:

AFFIRMATIVE DEFENSE. ANY PARTY WHO IS SUED FOR DAMAGES FOR VIOLATION OF A PATENT, TRADEMARK, OR OTHER INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS ON THE GROUND THE PARTY POSSESSED OR USED SEEDS OR PLANTS THAT CONTAINED GENET-7 ICALLY ENGINEERED OR GENETICALLY MODIFIED ORGANISMS WITHOUT ENTERING MANUFACTURER OR LICENSED 8 AGREEMENT OR PAYING FEES ANTO THE9 DISTRIBUTOR OF SUCH GENETICALLY ENGINEERED OR GENETICALLY MODIFIED ORGANISMS SHALL HAVE AN AFFIRMATIVE DEFENSE AGAINST ANY LIABILITY IF THE 10 PARTY SHALL SHOW THAT HE OR SHE DID NOT KNOWINGLY AND INTENTIONALLY 11 INTRODUCE THE GENETICALLY ENGINEERED OR GENETICALLY MODIFIED 12 ORGANISMS

13 INTO HIS OR HER PLANTS OR SEEDS OR ONTO HIS OR HER PROPERTY AND HE OR

14 SHE DID NOT KNOWINGLY GAIN FROM THE DISTINCTIVE TRAITS DUE TO GENETIC

15 MODIFICATION OR GENETIC ENGINEERING.

16 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
