AN ACT to amend the criminal procedure law, in relation to the victim's
statement at the sentencing of a criminal defendant

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-
BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subparagraph 2 of paragraph (a) of subdivision 2 of section
2 380.50 of the criminal procedure law, as separately amended by chapters
3 173 and 198 of the laws of 1996, is amended to read as follows:
4 (2) if such victim is unable or unwilling to express himself or
5 herself before the court or a person so mentally or physically disabled
6 as to make it impracticable to appear in court in person or the victim
7 is deceased OR IF SUCH VICTIM IS UNDER THE AGE OF EIGHTEEN, a member of
8 the family of such victim, or the legal guardian or representative of
9 the legal guardian of the victim where such guardian or representative
10 has personal knowledge of and a relationship with the victim, unless the
11 court finds that it would be inappropriate for such person to make a
12 statement on behalf of the victim.
13 S 2. This act shall take effect on the sixtieth day after it shall
14 have become a law.
