AN ACT to amend the criminal procedure law, in relation to granting certain federal law enforcement officers the power to act as peace officers; and to repeal subdivision 6 of section 2.15 of such law relating to Federal Protective Officers

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1     Section 1. Subdivisions 3 and 7 of section 2.15 of the criminal procedure law, subdivision 3 as amended by chapter 522 of the laws of 1995  
2     and subdivision 7 as amended by chapter 68 of the laws of 1983, are  
3     amended to read as follows:  
4     3. UNITED STATES Immigration and [Naturalization Service immigration  
5     inspectors, special agents, patrol officers and] CUSTOMS ENFORCEMENT  
6     SPECIAL AGENTS, deportation officers, IMMIGRATION ENFORCEMENT AGENTS,  
7     FEDERAL PROTECTIVE SERVICE OFFICERS AND AGENTS, AND ANY OTHER EMPLOYEE  
8     OF SUCH AGENCY AUTHORIZED TO MAKE ARRESTS UNDER FEDERAL LAW.  
9     7. United States Customs [Service special agents, inspectors and  
10    patrol] AND BORDER PROTECTION officers, BORDER PATROL AGENTS, AIR AND  
11    MARINE INTERDICTION AGENTS, AVIATION ENFORCEMENT AGENTS, INTERNAL  
12    AFFAIRS SPECIAL AGENTS, AND ANY OTHER EMPLOYEE OF SUCH AGENCY AUTHORIZED  
13    TO MAKE ARRESTS UNDER FEDERAL LAW.  
14    S 2. Subdivision 6 of section 2.15 of the criminal procedure law is  
15    REPEALED.  
16    S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
