AN ACT relating to school bus travel on the Palisades parkway; and providing for the repeal of such provisions upon expiration thereof

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Notwithstanding any law, rule, or regulation to the contra-
2 ry, the commissioner of the Palisades park commission shall promulgate
3 rules and regulations necessary to permit any school bus operated on
4 behalf of a private or public elementary school, secondary school or
5 camp in this state to use the Palisades parkway whether such school bus
6 is being used to transport pupils or is not being used to transport
7 pupils when on such parkway. For the purposes of this section, "school
8 bus" shall mean any vehicle or other means of conveyance used for the
9 purposes of transporting pupils or campers.
10 S 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred twentieth day after
11 it shall have become a law and shall expire two years after such effec-
12 tive date when upon such date the provisions of this act shall be deemed
13 repealed. Effective immediately, the addition, amendment and/or repeal
14 of any rule or regulation necessary for the implementation of this act
15 on its effective date is authorized and directed to be made and
16 completed on or before such effective date.
