AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to all terrain vehicles and agricultural use

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 401 of the vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new subdivision 14 to read as follows:

3 14. REGISTRATION OF ALL TERRAIN VEHICLES OPERATED UPON PUBLIC HIGHWAYS CONNECTING PORTIONS OF A FARM OR FARMS, MUNICIPAL SANITARY LANDFILLS AND 4 5 LICENSED MOTOR VEHICLE REPAIR SHOPS. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION 6 OF LAW ΤO THECONTRARY, ALL TERRAIN VEHICLES TO BE OPERATED BY ANY PERSON, UPON A PUBLIC HIGHWAY FOR THE PURPOSE OF TRAVELING BY 7 THE MOST 8 IN NO EVENT FURTHER THAN TWENTY-FIVE MILES ONE-WAY DIRECT ROUTE, BUT 9 FROM A POINT ON A FARM AS DESIGNATED BY THE VEHICLE OWNER AND SET FORTH IN AN ATTACHMENT TO THE VEHICLE REGISTRATION, (A) BETWEEN FIELDS, BUILD-10 INGS, AND FACILITIES MANAGED OR OPERATED AS PART OF A SINGLE FARM ENTER-11 PRISE IN CONNECTION WITH PRODUCTION, HARVESTING, PROCESSING OR MARKETING 12 ON THAT FARM OF CROPS, LIVESTOCK, OR LIVESTOCK PRODUCTS PRODUCED ON THAT 13 14 FARM; OR (B) FOR THE PURPOSE OF TRANSPORTING MATERIALS FROM A FARM TO THE NEAREST AVAILABLE MUNICIPAL 15 SANITARY LANDFILL; OR (C) FOR THE 16 PURPOSE OF TRANSPORTING THE ALL TERRAIN VEHICLE TO A MOTOR VEHICLE 17 REPAIR SHOP LICENSED PURSUANT TO THIS CHAPTER FOR THE REPAIR OR ADJUST-MENT OF EQUIPMENT PROVIDED THAT, IN ADDITION TO THE ROUTE RESTRICTIONS 18 19 SET FORTH IN THIS SUBDIVISION, NO SUCH TRANSPORT SHALL BE AUTHORIZED (I) 20 IF SUCH VEHICLE HAS AN OUT-OF-SERVICE DEFECT RELATING TO LOAD SECURE-STEERING COMPONENTS AND/OR COUPLING DEVICES, OR 21 MENT, BRAKE SYSTEMS, 22 AFTER IT HAS BEEN PLACED OUT-OF-SERVICE; (II) ON ANY LIMITED ACCESS 23 (III) DURING THE PERIOD OF ONE HOUR BEFORE SUNSET TO ONE HIGHWAY; AND 24 HOUR AFTER SUNRISE, MAY BE REGISTERED AS PROVIDED IN THIS SUBDIVISION. 25 EVERY OWNER OF SUCH VEHICLES MAY CAUSE TO BE FILED BY MAIL OR OTHERWISE,

WITH THE COMMISSIONER OR WITH ANY AGENT OF THE COMMISSIONER, AN APPLICA-1 TION FOR REGISTRATION OF SUCH VEHICLE, ADDRESSED TO THE COMMISSIONER, 2 3 AND ON A BLANK TO BE FURNISHED BY THE COMMISSIONER FOR THAT PURPOSE, 4 CONTAINING THE INFORMATION REQUIRED BY SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS SECTION 5 AND SUCH OTHER INFORMATION AS THE COMMISSIONER SHALL REQUIRE. THE COMMISSIONER OR AGENT SHALL MAKE SUCH INVESTIGATION, AS HE OR SHE SHALL 6 7 DETERMINE NECESSARY, AND IF SATISFIED THAT THE VEHICLE IS TO BE OPERATED EXCLUSIVELY AS PROVIDED IN THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL, UPON THE PAYMENT OF A 8 FEE OF ONE DOLLAR, ASSIGN TO SUCH VEHICLE A DISTINCTIVE NUMBER AND ISSUE 9 10 AND DELIVER TO THE APPLICANT A SET OF NUMBER PLATES AND A CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION IN SUCH FORM AS THE COMMISSIONER SHALL PRESCRIBE, INDICAT-11 12 ING THE EXTENT TO WHICH THE VEHICLE REGISTERED MAY BE OPERATED ON THE PUBLIC HIGHWAYS AND SUCH VEHICLE MAY BE OPERATED ONLY AS SO INDICATED. 13 14 FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SUBDIVISION, THE TERMS "FARM" AND "CROPS, LIVE-STOCK OR LIVESTOCK PRODUCTS, " SHALL HAVE THE SAME MEANING AS "LAND USED IN AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTION" AND "CROPS, LIVESTOCK AND LIVESTOCK 15 16 PRODUCTS, " RESPECTIVELY, AS DEFINED IN SECTION THREE HUNDRED ONE OF THE 17 AGRICULTURE AND MARKETS LAW, EXCEPT THAT FARMERS WITH AN AVERAGE GROSS 18 19 SALES VALUE OF AT LEAST ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS PER YEAR OF CROPS, LIVE-STOCK, AND LIVESTOCK PRODUCTS SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO REGISTER VEHICLES 20 21 PURSUANT TO THIS SUBDIVISION.
