- AN ACT to amend the public service law, in relation to requiring telegraph and telephone corporations to offer residential rates to religious organizations

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 3 of section 92 of the public service law, as 2 amended by chapter 124 of the laws of 1911, is amended to read as 3 follows:

3. [No] (A) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (B) OF 4 THIS SUBDIVISION, NO telegraph corporation or telephone corporation subject 5 to the provisions of this chapter shall, directly or indirectly, 6 qive 7 any free or reduced service, or any free pass or frank for the transmission of messages by either telephone or telegraph between points 8 within this state, except to its officers, employees, agents, pension-9 10 ers, surgeons, physicians, attorneys-at-law and their families; to persons or corporations exclusively engaged in charitable and eleemosy-11 nary work and ministers of religions; to officers and employees of other 12 telegraph corporations and telephone corporations, railroad corporations 13 and street railroad corporations. But this subdivision shall not apply 14 15 to state, municipal or federal contracts.

(B) NO TELEGRAPH CORPORATION OR TELEPHONE CORPORATION SHALL, DIRECTLY 16 17 OR INDIRECTLY, CHARGE, DEMAND, COLLECT OR RECEIVE A RATE, WHICH IS IN APPLICABLE RESIDENTIAL RATE FOR 18 EXCESS OF THE THE TRANSMISSION OF 19 MESSAGES BY EITHER TELEPHONE OR TELEGRAPH BETWEEN POINTS WITHIN THE 20 FROM ANY CORPORATION OR ASSOCIATION ORGANIZED AND CONDUCTED IN STATE, 21 GOOD FAITH FOR RELIGIOUS PURPOSES, INCLUDING THE OPERATION OF A SCHOOL 22 REGARDLESS OF WHETHER SECULAR SUBJECTS ARE TAUGHT THEREIN, WHEN SUCH
