AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to the creation of the police cadet corps program

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The executive law is amended by adding a new section 837-s
2 to read as follows:
3 S 837-S. POLICE CADET CORPS PROGRAM. 1. THERE IS HEREBY CREATED WITHIN
4 THE DIVISION A POLICE CADET CORPS PROGRAM, TO BE ADMINISTERED BY THE
5 COMMISSIONER IN CONJUNCTION AND CONSULTATION WITH THE CHANCELLOR OF THE
6 CITY UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK AND COMMISSIONER OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OF
7 THE CITY OF NEW YORK, TO BE LOCATED AT JOHN JAY COLLEGE WITHIN THE CITY
8 UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK.
9 2. SUCH PROGRAM SHALL BE DESIGNED SO AS TO PREPARE CANDIDATES FOR THE
10 COMPLEXITIES OF MODERN POLICE WORK IN AN ETHNICALLY DIVERSE COMMUNITY
11 THROUGH A COMBINATION OF COLLEGE EDUCATION AND SKILL DEVELOPMENT TRAIN-
12 ING, AND SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO:
13 (A) SPECIALIZED COURSEWORK SPECIFIC TO LAW ENFORCEMENT;
14 (B) THE PREVENTION OF VICTIMIZATION;
15 (C) COMMUNITY RELATIONS IN POLICING;
16 (D) MENTAL AND PHYSICAL SKILL-DEVELOPMENT TRAINING SPECIFIC TO THE
17 NEEDS OF LAW ENFORCEMENT; AND
18 (E) SUPERVISED INTERNSHIPS UNDER THE AUSPICES OF THE NEW YORK CITY
19 POLICE DEPARTMENT.
20 3. SUCH PROGRAM SHALL BE DESIGNED SO AS TO ACCOMMODATE A MINIMUM OF
21 FIVE HUNDRED STUDENTS BY THE FIFTEENTH OF AUGUST AFTER THIS SECTION
22 TAKES EFFECT, AND A MINIMUM OF ONE THOUSAND STUDENTS WITHIN ONE YEAR OF
23 THE FIFTEENTH OF AUGUST AFTER THIS SECTION TAKES EFFECT.
24 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
