AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to marking parking spaces reserved for handicapped persons as tow-away zones

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 2 of section 1203-c of the
2 vehicle and traffic law, as amended by chapter 199 of the laws of 2005,
3 is amended to read as follows:
4 (a) The parking spaces designated pursuant to the provisions of this
5 section shall be clearly identified for use by handicapped persons which
6 designation shall include conspicuous and permanently installed above
7 grade signs which display the international symbol of access and which
8 shall be positioned from the parking space surface at a height of not
9 less than five feet nor more than seven feet and may include the use of
10 blue painted lines or markings. Such parking spaces also [may] SHALL be
11 marked as tow-away zones.
12 S 2. This act shall take effect one year after it shall have become a
13 law.
