AN ACT to amend the state finance law, in relation to establishing a responsible bidders database in the office of the state comptroller

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Responsi-2 ble Bidders Database Act".

3 S 2. The state finance law is amended by adding a new section 147 to 4 read as follows:

5 RESPONSIBLE BIDDERS COMPUTERIZED DATABASE; S 147. REPORTING OF 6 CONTRACTED GOODS AND SERVICES. 1. THE STATE COMPTROLLER SHALL MAINTAIN A COMPUTERIZED DATABASE SYSTEM THAT SHALL CONTAIN INFORMATION FOR EVERY 7 8 FOR A STATE AGENCY OR PUBLIC AUTHORITY. THE STATE COMPTROLLER CONTRACT 9 SHALL MAINTAIN THE INFORMATION REOUIRED BY THIS SECTION IN A FORM THAT WILL ENABLE EACH AGENCY AND PUBLIC AUTHORITY TO PERFORM ITS DUTIES. 10

EACH STATE AGENCY AND PUBLIC AUTHORITY SHALL COLLECT THE INFORMA-11 2. TION SET FORTH IN THIS SUBDIVISION FOR EACH CONTRACT THAT THE AGENCY OR 12 PUBLIC AUTHORITY ENTERS INTO, AND SHALL PROVIDE THIS INFORMATION TO THE 13 14 STATE COMPTROLLER. THE INFORMATION SHALL BE SUBMITTED IN A FORM OR FORMAT AND ON A SCHEDULE TO BE DETERMINED BY THE STATE COMPTROLLER. THE 15 INFORMATION SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO, AT LEAST THE FOLLOWING 16 17 DATA:

18 A. THE CURRENT ADDRESSES AND TELEPHONE NUMBERS OF THE CONTRACTOR'S 19 PRINCIPAL EXECUTIVE OFFICES AND THE CONTRACTOR'S PRIMARY PLACE OF BUSI-20 NESS IN NEW YORK STATE, IF DIFFERENT.

B. THE ADDRESSES OF THE THREE LARGEST SITES AT WHICH IT IS ANTICIPATED
 THAT WORK WOULD OCCUR IN CONNECTION WITH THE PROPOSED CONTRACT, BASED ON
 THE NUMBER OF PERSONS TO BE EMPLOYED AT EACH SITE.

INFORMATION REQUIRED FROM A CONTRACTOR CONSISTING OF A CONTRACTOR'S SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER SHALL BE OBTAINED BY THE AGENCY OR PUBLIC AUTHOR-36 ITY ENTERING INTO A CONTRACT AS PART OF THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE TAXES 37 38 ADMINISTERED BY THE STATE COMMISSIONER OF TAXATION AND FINANCE FOR THE 39 PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING THE IDENTIFICATION OF PERSONS AFFECTED BY SUCH 40 TAXES. NO CONTRACT FOR GOODS OR SERVICES INVOLVING THE EXPENDITURE OF MORE 4 THAN TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS OR IN THE CASE OF CONSTRUCTION, REPAIR, REHA-5 BILITATION OR ALTERATION, THE EXPENDITURE OF MORE THAN FIFTEEN THOUSAND 6 DOLLARS, FRANCHISE OR CONCESSION SHALL BE LET BY AN AGENCY OR PUBLIC 7 AUTHORITY, UNLESS THE CONTRACT MANAGER OR OTHER PERSON RESPONSIBLE FOR 8 MAKING THE RECOMMENDATION FOR AWARD HAS CERTIFIED THAT THESE COMPUTER-

9 IZED DATABASES AND THE INFORMATION MAINTAINED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION 10 HAVE BEEN EXAMINED.

11 8. NOTHING IN THIS SECTION SHALL BE DEEMED TO REQUIRE THE DISCLOSURE 12 OF INFORMATION THAT IS CONFIDENTIAL OR PRIVILEGED OR THE DISCLOSURE OF 13 WHICH WOULD BE CONTRARY TO LAW IN THE ABSENCE OF THIS SECTION.

14 9. ANY CONTRACTOR OR SUBCONTRACTOR THAT HAS SUBMITTED TO ANY AGENCY OR 15 PUBLIC AUTHORITY THE INFORMATION REQUIRED TO BE PROVIDED IN ACCORDANCE 16 WITH SUBDIVISION TWO OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE REQUIRED TO UPDATE THAT INFORMATION ONLY AT THREE-YEAR INTERVALS, EXCEPT THAT INFORMATION 17 18 REQUIRED BY PARAGRAPHS N, O, Q, R, V, W AND X OF SUBDIVISION TWO OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE UPDATED EACH TIME THE CONTRACTOR OR SUBCONTRACTOR IS 19 20 CONSIDERED FOR THE AWARD OF ANOTHER CONTRACT OR SUBCONTRACT, EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBDIVISION FIVE OR SIX OF THIS SECTION, AND NO CONTRACT OR 21 SUBCONTRACT SHALL BE AWARDED UNLESS THE CONTRACTOR OR SUBCONTRACTOR HAS 22 CERTIFIED THAT INFORMATION PREVIOUSLY SUBMITTED AS TO THOSE REQUIREMENTS 23 24 IS CORRECT AT THE TIME OF THE AWARD OF THE CONTRACT OR SUBCONTRACT.

25 10. EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED, FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION: 26 A. "AFFILIATE" SHALL MEAN AN ENTITY IN WHICH THE PARENT OF THE 27 CONTRACTOR OWNS MORE THAN FIFTY PERCENT OF THE VOTING STOCK, OR AN ENTI-IN WHICH A GROUP OF PRINCIPAL OWNERS WHICH OWNS MORE THAN FIFTY 28 ΤY 29 PERCENT OF THE CONTRACTOR ALSO OWNS MORE THAN FIFTY PERCENT OF THE 30 VOTING STOCK.

B. "CAUTIONARY INFORMATION" SHALL MEAN, IN REGARD TO A CONTRACTOR, ANY
 ADVERSE ACTION BY ANY AGENCY OR PUBLIC AUTHORITY, INCLUDING BUT NOT
 LIMITED TO POOR PERFORMANCE EVALUATION, DEFAULT, NON-RESPONSIBILITY
 DETERMINATION, DEBARMENT, SUSPENSION, WITHDRAWAL OF PREQUALIFIED STATUS,
 OR DENIAL OF PREQUALIFIED STATUS.

"CONTRACT" SHALL MEAN AND INCLUDE ANY AGREEMENT BETWEEN AN AGENCY 36 С. 37 OR PUBLIC AUTHORITY AND A CONTRACTOR, OR ANY AGREEMENT BETWEEN SUCH A CONTRACTOR AND A SUBCONTRACTOR, WHICH (I) IS FOR THE PROVISION OF GOODS, 38 39 SERVICES OR CONSTRUCTION AND HAS A VALUE THAT WHEN AGGREGATED WITH THE 40 VALUES OF ALL OTHER SUCH AGREEMENTS WITH THE SAME CONTRACTOR OR SUBCON-TRACTOR AND ANY FRANCHISES OR CONCESSIONS AWARDED TO SUCH CONTRACTOR OR 41 SUBCONTRACTOR DURING THE IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING 42 TWELVE-MONTH PERIOD IS 43 VALUED AT ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS OR MORE; OR (II) IS FOR THE 44 PROVISION OF GOODS, SERVICES OR CONSTRUCTION IS AWARDED TO A SOLE SOURCE 45 AND IS VALUED AT TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS OR MORE; OR (III) IS A CONCESSION HAS A VALUE THAT WHEN AGGREGATED WITH THE VALUE OF ALL OTHER 46 AND 47 CONTRACTS HELD BY THE SAME CONCESSIONAIRE IS VALUED AT ONE HUNDRED THOU-48 SAND DOLLARS OR MORE; OR (IV) IS A FRANCHISE.

D. "CONTRACTOR" SHALL MEAN AND INCLUDE ALL INDIVIDUALS, SOLE PROPRIE-TORSHIPS, PARTNERSHIPS, JOINT VENTURES OR CORPORATIONS WHO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT, AS DEFINED IN PARAGRAPH C OF THIS SUBDIVISION, WITH AN AGENCY OR PUBLIC AUTHORITY.

53 E. "OFFICER" SHALL MEAN ANY INDIVIDUAL WHO SERVES AS CHIEF EXECUTIVE 54 OFFICER, CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER, OR CHIEF OPERATING OFFICER OF THE 55 CONTRACTOR, BY WHATEVER TITLES KNOWN. 1 F. "PARENT" SHALL MEAN AN INDIVIDUAL PARTNERSHIP, JOINT VENTURE OR 2 CORPORATION, WHICH OWNS MORE THAN FIFTY PERCENT OF THE VOTING STOCK OF A 3 CONTRACTOR.

4 G. "PRINCIPAL OWNER" SHALL MEAN AN INDIVIDUAL, PARTNERSHIP, JOINT 5 VENTURE OR CORPORATION WHICH HOLDS A TEN PERCENT OR GREATER OWNERSHIP 6 INTEREST IN A CONTRACTOR OR SUBCONTRACTOR.

7 H. "SUBCONTRACT" SHALL MEAN ANY CONTRACT, AS DEFINED IN PARAGRAPH C OF 8 THIS SUBDIVISION, BETWEEN A SUBCONTRACTOR AND A CONTRACTOR.

9 I. "SUBCONTRACTOR" SHALL MEAN AN INDIVIDUAL, SOLE PROPRIETORSHIP, 10 PARTNERSHIP, JOINT VENTURE OR CORPORATION WHICH IS ENGAGED BY A CONTRAC-11 TOR PURSUANT TO A CONTRACT, AS DEFINED IN PARAGRAPH C OF THIS SUBDIVI-12 SION.

13 11. THE STATE COMPTROLLER MAY ENTER INTO COOPERATIVE AGREEMENTS FOR 14 THE EXCHANGE OF INFORMATION WITH ANY MUNICIPALITY THAT MAINTAINS A DATA-15 BASE SUBSTANTIALLY SIMILAR TO THE ONE REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION.

16 S 3. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 17 have become a law.
