AN ACT to amend the workers' compensation law, in relation to eliminating the requirement that copies of the report of independent medical examination must be submitted to all parties in the same manner

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 1 of section 137 of the workers' compensation law, as added by chapter 473 of the laws of 2000, is amended to read as follows:
- (a) (I) A copy of each report of independent medical examination shall be submitted by the practitioner on the same day and in the same manner to [the board,] the insurance carrier, the claimant's attending physician or other attending practitioner, the claimant's representative and the claimant.
- 9 (II) A COPY OF THE REPORT OF INDEPENDENT MEDICAL EXAMINATION SHALL BE 10 SUBMITTED TO THE BOARD IN THE MANNER OR MANNERS PRESCRIBED BY THE CHAIR 11 ON THE SAME DAY THAT IT IS SUBMITTED TO THE INSURANCE CARRIER, THE 12 CLAIMANT'S ATTENDING PHYSICIAN OR OTHER ATTENDING PRACTITIONER, THE 13 CLAIMANT'S REPRESENTATIVE AND THE CLAIMANT.
- 14 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
