AN ACT to amend the mental hygiene law, in relation to authorizing the release of certain records of deceased residents of OMRDD operated or certified facilities to family members upon written request

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision (f) of section 13.09 of the mental hygiene law, as added by chapter 520 of the laws of 2008, is relettered subdivision (h) and a new subdivision (g) is added to read as follows:

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(G) NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF SECTIONS 33.13 AND 33.16 OF THIS 5 COMMISSIONER SHALL PROMULGATE REGULATIONS TO AUTHORIZE, THEUPON WRITTEN REQUEST AND AS DETERMINED ON A CASE-BY-CASE BASIS, 7 RELEASE OF CERTAIN RECORDS PERTAINING TO A DECEASED INDIVIDUAL WHO 8 RESIDED IN A FACILITY OPERATED OR CERTIFIED BY THE OFFICE. THE REGU-9 LATIONS SHALL SPECIFY WHICH INFORMATION MAY BE RELEASED AND SHALL 10 INCLUDE CONSIDERATION OF SUCH INFORMATION AS THE INDIVIDUAL'S DATES OF ADMISSION, DISCHARGE, BIRTH AND DEATH; CAUSE OF DEATH; A SUMMA-11 RY OF THE DIAGNOSIS, TREATMENT, AND SERVICES PROVIDED; EMPLOYMENT; RESI-12 DENTIAL AND FAMILY HISTORY; AND OTHER IDENTIFYING DATA. 13 THE REGULATIONS 14 SPECIFY THE CIRCUMSTANCES UNDER WHICH SUCH RECORDS SHALL BE 15 RELEASED AND SHALL INCLUDE CONSIDERATION OF THE NEED OF A FAMILY 16 OTHER THAN A QUALIFIED PERSON AS DEFINED IN PARAGRAPH SIX OF SUBDIVISION (A) OF SECTION 33.16 OF THIS CHAPTER TO ACCESS INFORMATION. IN THE EVENT 17 THE CASE OF AN INDIVIDUAL WHO LACKED 18 THE DECEASED INDIVIDUAL, OR INCAPACITY TO CONSENT TO THE RELEASE OF HIS OR HER RECORDS, A 19 20 PERSON AS DEFINED IN PARAGRAPH SIX OF SUBDIVISION (A) OF SECTION 33.16 21 OF THIS CHAPTER, HAD PREVIOUSLY OBJECTED TO THE RELEASE OF HIS 22 RECORDS AND SUCH OBJECTION WAS IN WRITING OR OTHERWISE DOCUMENTED IN THE

EXPLANATION--Matter in ITALICS (underscored) is new; matter in brackets [ ] is old law to be omitted.

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INDIVIDUAL'S SERVICES PLAN AND HAD NOT BEEN WITHDRAWN, THE COMMISSIONER SHALL NOT AUTHORIZE THE RELEASE OF SUCH RECORDS.

- S 2. Subdivision (c) of section 33.13 of the mental hygiene law is amended by adding a new paragraph 15 to read as follows:
- 5 15. UPON WRITTEN REQUEST TO THE PHYSICIAN OF A FAMILY MEMBER OF A 6 DECEASED INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS A DEMONSTRABLE MEDICAL NEED FOR SUCH INFOR7 MATION AS IT IS RELEVANT TO THE FAMILY MEMBER'S OWN HEALTH CARE.
- 8 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately; provided that section one 9 of this act shall take effect one hundred eighty days after it shall 10 have become a law.
