Introduced by Sens. MONTGOMERY, MARCELLINO, C. JOHNSON -- read twice and ordered printed, and when printed to be committed to the Committee on Children and Families

AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to requiring at least one employee of any child day care facility to be trained and certified in cardiopulmonary resuscitation and first aid

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1     Section 1. Section 390-a of the social services law is amended by  
2     adding a new subdivision 5 to read as follows:  
3     5. A. THE SITE PROVIDER OF A FAMILY DAY CARE HOME OR GROUP FAMILY DAY  
4     CARE HOME SHALL PROVIDE THAT AT LEAST ONE EMPLOYEE WHO HOLDS A VALID  
5     CERTIFICATION IN A COURSE OF STUDY IN FIRST AID KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS AND  
6     CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION, WITH AN EMPHASIS ON PROVIDING THAT AID TO  
7     CHILDREN, AS APPROVED BY THE COMMISSIONER OF THE OFFICE OF CHILDREN AND  
8     FAMILY SERVICES, BE ON PREMISES DURING THE OPERATING HOURS OF SUCH FAMI-  
9     LY DAY CARE HOME OR GROUP FAMILY DAY CARE HOME.  
10    B. THE SITE SUPERVISOR OF A SCHOOL-AGE CHILD CARE PROGRAM SHALL  
11    PROVIDE THAT AT LEAST ONE EMPLOYEE WHO HOLDS A VALID CERTIFICATION IN A  
12    COURSE OF STUDY IN FIRST AID KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS AND CARDIOPULMONARY  
13    RESUSCITATION, WITH AN EMPHASIS ON PROVIDING THAT AID TO CHILDREN, AS  
14    APPROVED BY THE COMMISSIONER OF THE OFFICE OF CHILDREN AND FAMILY  
15    SERVICES, BE ON PREMISES DURING THE OPERATING HOURS OF SUCH SCHOOL-AGE  
16    CHILD CARE PROGRAM.  
17    C. THE DIRECTOR OF A CHILD DAY CARE CENTER SHALL PROVIDE THAT AT LEAST  
18    ONE EMPLOYEE WHO HOLDS A VALID CERTIFICATION IN A COURSE OF STUDY IN  
19    FIRST AID KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS AND CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION, WITH  
20    AN EMPHASIS ON PROVIDING THAT AID TO CHILDREN, AS APPROVED BY THE  
21    COMMISSIONER OF THE OFFICE OF CHILDREN AND FAMILY SERVICES, BE ON PREM-  
22    ISES DURING THE OPERATING HOURS OF SUCH CHILD DAY CARE CENTER.
