AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to requirements of proof for certain licenses

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subparagraph (i) of paragraph (a) of subdivision 3 of section 490 of the vehicle and traffic law, as amended by chapter 235 of the laws of 2002, is amended to read as follows:

- (i) The commissioner shall upon submission of an appropriate application, upon payment of the prescribed fee, and upon being satisfied that the person described is the applicant and that such applicant meets the requirements set forth in subdivision two of this section, issue to such applicant a nontransferable identification card. In addition, the commissioner also shall require that an applicant for an identification card or renewal thereof provide his or her social security number, OR PROVIDE PROOF THAT HE OR SHE IS NOT ELIGIBLE FOR A SOCIAL SUCH PROOF MAY INCLUDE ANY DOCUMENTS SUBMITTED BY AN APPLICANT TO THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DETERMINING WHETHER SUCH APPLICANT IS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE A SOCIAL SECU-RITY NUMBER.
- 16 S 2. Subdivision 1 of section 502 of the vehicle and traffic law, as 17 amended by chapter 639 of the laws of 2006, is amended to read as 18 follows:
 - 1. Application for license. Application for a driver's license shall be made to the commissioner. The fee prescribed by law may be submitted with such application. The applicant shall furnish such proof of identity, age, and fitness as may be required by the commissioner. The commissioner may also provide that the application procedure shall include the taking of a photo image or images of the applicant in accordance with

rules and regulations prescribed by the commissioner. In addition, the commissioner [also] shall require that the applicant provide his or her 3 security number [and], OR PROVIDE PROOF THAT HE OR SHE IS NOT FOR A SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER. SUCH PROOF MAY INCLUDE ANY DOCU-5 MENTS SUBMITTED BY AN APPLICANT TO THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOME-6 LAND SECURITY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DETERMINING WHETHER SUCH APPLICANT 7 TO RECEIVE A SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL 8 ALSO provide space on the application so that the applicant may register in the New York state organ and tissue donor registry under section 9 10 forty-three hundred ten of the public health law. In addition, an appli-11 cant for a commercial driver's license who will operate a commercial 12 motor vehicle in interstate commerce shall certify that such applicant meets the requirements to operate a commercial motor vehicle, as set 13 14 forth in public law 99-570, title XII, and title 49 of the code of 15 federal regulations, and all regulations promulgated by the United States secretary of transportation under the hazardous materials trans-16 17 portation act. Upon a determination that the holder of a commercial 18 driver's license has made any false statement, with respect to 19 application for such license, the commissioner shall revoke 20 license.

- S 3. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 6 of section 502 of the vehicle and traffic law, as amended by chapter 81 of the laws of 1995, is amended to read as follows:
- A license issued pursuant to subdivision five of this section shall be valid until the expiration date contained thereon, unless license is suspended, revoked or cancelled. Such license may be renewed by submission of an application for renewal, the fee prescribed by prior licensing, fitness and acceptable vision prescribed by the commissioner, AND the applicant's social security number, [and if required by the commissioner] OR PROVIDE PROOF THAT HE OR SHE IS NOT ELIGIBLE FOR A SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER. SUCH PROOF MAY INCLUDE ANY DOCU-MENTS SUBMITTED BY AN APPLICANT TO THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOME-SECURITY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DETERMINING WHETHER SUCH APPLICANT IS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE A SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER. THE COMMISSIONER MAY ALSO REQUIRE SUBMISSION OF a photo image of the applicant in such numbers and form as the commissioner shall prescribe. In addition, an applicant for a license containing a hazardous material endorsement shall pass an examination to retain such endorsement. A renewal of such license shall be issued by the commissioner upon approval of such application, except that no such license shall be issued if its issuance would be inconsistent with the provisions of section five hundred sixteen of this chapter, and except that the commissioner may refuse to renew such license if the applicant is the holder of a currently valid or renewable license to drive issued by another state or foreign country unless the applicant surrenders such license.
 - S 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
