AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to residual amounts of a controlled substance

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The penal law is amended by adding a new section 220.30 to
2 read as follows:
3 S 220.30 CRIMINAL POSSESSION OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE; EXEMPTION.
4 A PERSON SHALL NOT BE GUILTY OF CRIMINAL POSSESSION OF A CONTROLLED
5 SUBSTANCE WHERE HE OR SHE POSSESSES A RESIDUAL AMOUNT OF A CONTROLLED
6 SUBSTANCE WHEN THAT RESIDUAL AMOUNT IS IN A HYPODERMIC SYRINGE OR HYPO-
7 DERMIC NEEDLE POSSESSED PURSUANT TO SUBDIVISION ONE OF SECTION
8 THIRTY-THREE HUNDRED EIGHTY-ONE OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH LAW AND OBTAINED BY
9 SUCH PERSON PURSUANT TO PARAGRAPH (B) OF SUBDIVISION ONE OF SECTION
10 THIRTY-THREE HUNDRED EIGHTY-ONE OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH LAW OR FROM A PHAR-
11 MACY, HEALTH CARE FACILITY OR HEALTH CARE PRACTITIONER PURSUANT TO PARA-
12 GRAPH (C) OF SUBDIVISION ONE OF SECTION THIRTY-THREE HUNDRED EIGHTY-ONE
13 OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH LAW.
14 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
