AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to contingency budgets in school districts with more than 5 percent of their enrollment in charter schools

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 2023 of the education law is amended by adding a
2 new subdivision 5 to read as follows:
3 5. FOR THE TWO THOUSAND NINE--TWO THOUSAND TEN SCHOOL YEAR, NOTWITH-
4 STANDING THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF ANY
5 SCHOOL DISTRICT WITH MORE THAN FIVE PERCENT OF ENROLLMENT ATTENDING
6 CHARTER SCHOOLS MAY ADOPT A CONTINGENCY BUDGET WITHIN THE CAP REQUIRED
7 BY SUBDIVISION FOUR OF THIS SECTION AND INCLUDING ANY EXPENSES OF THE
8 DISTRICT DEEMED NECESSARY FOR OPERATION BY THE BOARD OF EDUCATION SUCH
9 AS EQUIPMENT, STUDENT SUPPLIES, PUBLIC USE OF SCHOOL BUILDINGS WITHOUT A
10 FEE AND SALARY INCREASES FOR NON-CONTRACTUAL EMPLOYEES.
11 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
