AN ACT to amend the real property tax law, in relation to redemption of certain property owned by persons deployed by the United States military

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "veteran
2 home redemption relief act".
3 S 2. The real property tax law is amended by adding a new section 1115
4 to read as follows:
5 S 1115. WAIVER OF INTEREST, PENALTIES AND FEES FOR REDEMPTION FOR
6 CERTAIN PERSONS DEPLOYED BY THE MILITARY. A COUNTY, CITY, TOWN, VILLAGE
7 OR OTHER TAXING ENTITY MAY BY LAW, ORDINANCE OR REGULATION OF GENERAL
8 APPLICABILITY PERMIT THE FORMER OWNER OR THE SURVIVING SPOUSE OR DOMES-
9 TIC PARTNER OF THE FORMER OWNER OF RESIDENTIAL REAL ESTATE FORECLOSED
10 WITHIN THE PRECEDING THREE YEARS TO REDEEM SUCH REAL ESTATE WITHOUT
11 INTEREST, PENALTIES AND FEES OWED TO SUCH GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY, PROVIDED
12 THAT:
13 (1) THE PROPERTY WAS THE FORMER OWNER'S PRINCIPAL PLACE OF RESIDENCE;
14 (2) THE FORECLOSURE WAS A RESULT OF FINANCIAL HARDSHIP CAUSED IN
15 SUBSTANTIAL PART BY THE OWNER'S HAVING BEEN ORDERED TO ACTIVE MILITARY
16 DUTY IN THE UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES INCLUDING THE RESERVE COMPONENTS
17 OF SUCH ARMED FORCES;

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1 (3) THE OWNER'S MILITARY ACTIVATION LASTED FOR AT LEAST SIX CONTIGUOUS
2 MONTHS, OR THE OWNER WAS KILLED IN ACTION DURING SUCH ACTIVATION;

3 (4) THE TITLE TO THE PROPERTY HAS NOT BEEN ACQUIRED BY A BONA FIDE
4 PURCHASER WHO WILL USE IT FOR HIS OR HER OWN PRIMARY RESIDENCE; AND

5 (5) THE FORMER OWNER PROVIDES SATISFACTORY WRITTEN EVIDENCE OF THE
6 REQUIREMENTS SET FORTH IN THIS SECTION TO THE CHIEF ELECTED OFFICER OF
7 SUCH COUNTY, CITY, TOWN, VILLAGE OR TAXING ENTITY, OR THEIR DESIGNEE, OR
8 ANY OTHER OFFICIAL THAT MAY BE DESIGNATED BY SUCH LAW, ORDINANCE OR
9 REGULATION.

10 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
