AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to including the Chaumont River within the definition of "inland waterways" for the purposes of waterfront revitalization

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 4 of section 911 of the executive law, as sepa-  
2 rately amended by chapters 185, 186 and 363 of the laws of 2008 and  
3 paragraph (b) as separately amended by chapter 103 of the laws of 2008,  
4 is amended to read as follows:

5 4. "Inland waterways" shall mean (a) the state's major inland lakes  
6 consisting of lakes Big Tupper, Black, Canandaigua, Cayuga, Champlain,  
7 Chautauqua, Conesus, Cranberry, George, Great Sacandaga, Honoeeye, Indi-  
8 an, Keuka, Long, Oneida, Onondaga, Otisco, Otsego, Owasco, Raquette,  
9 Sacandaga, Saratoga, Schroon, Seneca, Skaneateles and Saranac, and the  
10 Fulton chain of lakes; (b) the state's major rivers comprised of the  
11 Ausable, Black, Boquet, Canisteo, CHAUMONT (INCLUDING CHAUMONT BAY),  
12 Chemung, Cohocton, Delaware, Deer, Genesee, Grasse, Hudson north of the  
13 federal dam at Troy, Indian, Little Salmon (including north and south  
14 branches), Mad, Mettowee, Mohawk, Oswegatchie, Racquette, Salmon, Sara-  
15 nac, Susquehanna, Tioga and Tioughnioga rivers, and the north and middle  
16 branches of the Moose river; (c) the state's major creeks comprised of  
17 the Cincinatti, East Kill, Esopus (including upper and lower branches),  
18 Fish (including east and west branches), Gooseberry, Little Sandy,  
19 Sandy, Schoharie, South Sandy, Oatka and Tonawanda and West Kill; (d)  
20 the Barge Canal System as defined in section two of the canal law; and  
21 (e) the adjacent shorelands to the extent that such inland waters and  
22 adjacent lands are strongly influenced by each other including, but not  
23 limited to, islands, wetlands, beaches, dunes, barrier islands, cliffs,  
24 bluffs and erosion prone areas.

25 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
