



1 B. EXAMINE AND REVIEW ALL FINANCIAL INFORMATION OF THE STATE FOR THE  
2 PURPOSE OF RENDERING REVENUE ESTIMATES USED IN DETERMINING WHETHER ANY  
3 PROPOSED STATE BUDGET IS BALANCED;

4 C. BE CHARGED WITH THE DUTY OF RENDERING ANTICIPATED REVENUE FORECAST  
5 REPORTS TO THE LEGISLATURE AND THE GOVERNOR FOR THE PURPOSES OF FACILI-  
6 TATING PASSAGE OF THE STATE BUDGET IN A TIMELY MANNER; AND

7 D. PROVIDE ASSISTANCE IN DETERMINING THE FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED  
8 LEGISLATION.

9 2. THE DIRECTOR MAY APPOINT BUDGET ANALYSTS, ASSISTANTS AND SUCH OTHER  
10 EMPLOYEES AS HE OR SHE MAY DEEM NECESSARY OR DESIRABLE, PRESCRIBE SUCH  
11 EMPLOYEE'S DUTIES AND FIX SUCH EMPLOYEE'S COMPENSATION WITHIN THE  
12 AMOUNTS APPROPRIATED AND MADE AVAILABLE THEREFOR. THE DIRECTOR MAY  
13 REQUEST AND SHALL RECEIVE FROM ALL PUBLIC OFFICERS, DEPARTMENTS, AGEN-  
14 CIES AND AUTHORITIES OF THE STATE AND ITS POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS, SUCH  
15 ASSISTANCE AND DATA AS SHALL BE NECESSARY TO PROJECT ANTICIPATED STATE  
16 REVENUES FOR BUDGETARY PURPOSES.

17 3. THE OFFICE SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE TEMPORARY PRESIDENT OF THE  
18 SENATE AND THE SPEAKER OF THE ASSEMBLY WHICH SHALL INCLUDE:

19 A. DOCUMENTATION OF FISCAL POLICIES OF THE STATE, INCLUDING BUDGET  
20 AUTHORITY;

21 B. WRITTEN ESTIMATES OF ANTICIPATED STATE REVENUES FOR BUDGETARY  
22 PURPOSES;

23 C. PROJECTED ECONOMIC FACTORS AND FORECASTS; AND

24 D. SUMMARIZATION OF THE BUDGET PROPOSED BY THE GOVERNOR PURSUANT TO  
25 ARTICLE SEVEN OF THE CONSTITUTION.

26 SUCH REPORT SHALL BE SUBMITTED ON THE FIRST OF MARCH EACH YEAR FOR THE  
27 NEXT SUCCEEDING FISCAL YEAR. AFTER SUBMISSION TO THE TEMPORARY PRESIDENT  
28 OF THE SENATE AND THE SPEAKER OF THE ASSEMBLY, SUCH REPORT SHALL BE MADE  
29 AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC, UPON REQUEST.

30 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
