AN ACT to amend the general municipal law, in relation to ensuring the protection in the municipal procurement process of information that would materially impair national, state or local security, materially impair emergency preparedness plans or reveal vulnerabilities relating to security

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 103 of the general municipal law is amended by
2 adding a new subdivision 13 to read as follows:
3 13. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS SECTION OR ANY OTHER
4 GENERAL, SPECIAL OR LOCAL LAW, RULE OR REGULATION, ALL CONTRACTS FOR
5 PUBLIC WORK OR PURCHASE CONTRACTS FOR WHICH THE APPLICABLE REQUIREMENTS
6 WOULD OTHERWISE REQUIRE DISCLOSURE OF INFORMATION THAT WOULD, IF
7 DISCLOSED, MATERIALLY IMPAIR NATIONAL, STATE OR LOCAL SECURITY, MATE-
8 Rially IMPAIR EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS PLANS OR REVEAL CURRENT VULNERABIL-
9 ITIES OF SYSTEMS, INSTALLATIONS, INFRASTRUCTURES, OR PROJECTS RELATING
10 TO NATIONAL, STATE OR LOCAL SECURITY SHALL BE PROCURED BY THE APPROPRI-
11 ATE OFFICER, BOARD OR AGENCY OF A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OR ANY DISTRICT
12 THEREIN CONSISTENT WITH SECTION ONE HUNDRED FOUR-B OF THIS ARTICLE. THE
13 DETERMINATION UNDER THIS SUBDIVISION OF WHETHER DISCLOSURE OF INFORMA-
14 TION WOULD MATERIALLY IMPAIR CURRENT NATIONAL, STATE OR LOCAL SECURITY,
15 MATERIALLY IMPAIR EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS PLANS OR REVEAL CURRENT VULNER-
16 ABILITIES OF SYSTEMS, INSTALLATIONS, INFRASTRUCTURES, OR PROJECTS RELAT-
17 ING TO NATIONAL, STATE OR LOCAL SECURITY SHALL BE MADE BY THE GOVERNING
18 BOARD OF A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OR DISTRICT THEREIN OR A PUBLIC OFFICER
19 OR BODY DESIGNATED BY SUCH BOARD, PROVIDED THAT SUCH DETERMINATION SHALL
20 BE MADE BY THE MAYOR AND COMPTROLLER IN CITIES WITH A POPULATION OF ONE
21 MILLION OR MORE. SUCH DETERMINATION SHALL BE EXEMPT FROM THE PROVISIONS
22 OF ARTICLE SEVEN OF THE PUBLIC OFFICERS LAW.

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1 S 2. Section 104-b of the general municipal law is amended by adding a
2 new subdivision 7 to read as follows:

3 7. NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF ANY OTHER GENERAL, SPECIAL OR
4 LOCAL LAW, RULE OR REGULATION, PURCHASES OF EQUIPMENT, GOODS OR
5 SERVICES, OR CONTRACTS FOR PUBLIC WORK, FOR WHICH THE APPLICABLE
6 REQUIREMENTS WOULD OTHERWISE REQUIRE DISCLOSURE OF INFORMATION THAT
7 WOULD, IF DISCLOSED, MATERIALLY IMPAIR CURRENT NATIONAL, STATE OR LOCAL
8 SECURITY, MATERIALLY IMPAIR EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS PLANS OR REVEAL
9 VULNERABILITIES OF SYSTEMS, INSTALLATIONS, INFRASTRUCTURES, OR PROJECTS
10 RELATING TO NATIONAL, STATE OR LOCAL SECURITY SHALL BE LET BY THE APPRO-
11 PRIATE OFFICER, BOARD OR AGENCY OF A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OR DISTRICT
12 THEREIN IN A MANNER CONSISTENT WITH THIS SECTION. THE GOVERNING BOARD
13 OF EVERY POLITICAL SUBDIVISION AND ANY DISTRICT THEREIN, BY RESOLUTION,
14 SHALL ADOPT INTERNAL POLICIES AND PROCEDURES GOVERNING PURCHASES AND
15 CONTRACTS TO WHICH THIS SUBDIVISION APPLIES TO ENSURE THAT SUCH INFORMA-
16 TION IS NOT DISCLOSED PURSUANT TO OTHERWISE APPLICABLE PROCUREMENT
17 PROCEDURES REQUIRED BY ANY GENERAL, SPECIAL OR LOCAL LAW, RULE OR REGU-
18 LATION. IN CITIES WITH A POPULATION OF ONE MILLION OR MORE, THE
19 PROCUREMENT POLICY BOARD SHALL DEVELOP AND PROMULGATE SUCH POLICIES AND
20 PROCEDURES BY RULE. THE DETERMINATION UNDER THIS SUBDIVISION OF WHETHER
21 DISCLOSURE OF INFORMATION WOULD MATERIALLY IMPAIR CURRENT NATIONAL,
22 STATE OR LOCAL SECURITY, MATERIALLY IMPAIR EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS PLANS
23 OR REVEAL CURRENT VULNERABILITIES OF SYSTEMS, INSTALLATIONS, INFRASTRUC-
24 TURES, OR PROJECTS RELATING TO NATIONAL, STATE OR LOCAL SECURITY SHALL
25 BE MADE BY THE GOVERNING BOARD OF A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OR DISTRICT
26 THEREIN OR A PUBLIC OFFICER OR BODY DESIGNATED BY SUCH BOARD, PROVIDED
27 THAT SUCH DETERMINATION SHALL BE MADE BY THE MAYOR AND COMPTROLLER IN
28 CITIES WITH A POPULATION OF ONE MILLION OR MORE. SUCH DETERMINATION
29 SHALL BE EXEMPT FROM THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE SEVEN OF THE PUBLIC OFFI-
30 CERS LAW.

31 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
