AN ACT to amend the real property tax law, in relation to the definition of "eligible tract" for the purposes of the taxation of forest land

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Paragraph (e) of subdivision 1 of section 480-a of the real
2 property tax law, as amended by chapter 428 of the laws of 1987, is
3 amended to read as follows:
4 (e) "Eligible tract" shall mean a tract of privately owned forest land
5 of at least [fifty] TWENTY-FIVE contiguous acres, exclusive of any
6 portion thereof not devoted to the production of forest crops. Lands
7 divided by federal, state, county or town roads, easements or rights-of-
8 way, or energy transmission corridors or similar facilities will be
9 considered contiguous for purposes of this section, unless vehicular
10 access for forest management purposes is precluded. Lands from which a
11 merchantable forest crop has been cut or removed within three years
12 prior to the time of application for certification under this section
13 will be ineligible unless such cutting or removal was accomplished under
14 a forest management program designed to provide for the continuing
15 production of merchantable forest crops.
16 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
