AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to the disposal of drugs by incineration

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Title 27 of article 27 of the environmental conservation 2 law, as added by chapter 625 of the laws of 2008, is amended by adding a 3 new section 27-2705 to read as follows:

4 S 27-2705. DISPOSAL OF DRUGS BY INCINERATION.

5 ANY COUNTY, TOWN, CITY OR VILLAGE IN THIS STATE MAY APPLY TO THE 6 DEPARTMENT FOR A PERMIT TO INCINERATE UNUSED, UNWANTED OR EXPIRED DRUGS 7 FACILITIES OWNED AND MAINTAINED BY SUCH COUNTY, TOWN, CITY OR AΤ 8 VILLAGE. SUCH APPLICATION FOR SUCH PERMIT SHALL BE IN A MANNER AND FORM BE DETERMINED BY THE DEPARTMENT. SUCH PERMIT, WHEN ISSUED, SHALL 9 ΤO PERMIT SUCH COUNTY, TOWN, CITY OR VILLAGE TO DISPOSE OF DRUGS BY INCIN-10 ERATION WITHOUT FIRST OBTAINING A VARIANCE FROM THE DEPARTMENT. AS PART 11 OF THE APPLICATION PROCESS, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL TAKE SUFFICIENT 12 STEPS AND MAKE SUFFICIENT INSPECTIONS OF THE INCINERATION FACILITIES FOR WHICH 13 SUCH PERMIT IS SOUGHT IN ORDER TO INSURE THAT THE DISPOSAL OF DRUGS BY 14 INCINERATION SHALL BE HAD IN A MANNER TO COMPLY WITH ALL ENVIRONMENTAL 15 AND HEALTH REQUIREMENTS ASSOCIATED WITH SUCH INCINERATION. 16

17 S 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall 18 have become a law.
