AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to ballots which are counted by machine

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 7-121 of the election law, as added by chapter 352
2 of the laws of 1986, is amended to read as follows:
3 S 7-121. Ballots which are counted by machine. [A board of elections
4 may provide, by resolution adopted at least two months before an
5 election at which voting machines are used, that all ballots cast for
6 such election, other than on the voting machines, shall be counted by a
7 machine of a type] ALL BALLOTS PRINTED FOR USE ON A VOTING SYSTEM
8 approved by the state board of elections [and that all ballots printed
9 for use at such election] may be printed and arranged in a manner which
10 would permit them to be counted by such machine.
11 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
