AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to collision damage waiver caps

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 2 of section 396-z of the
2 general business law, as amended by chapter 731 of the laws of 2006, is
3 amended to read as follows:
4 (a) A rental vehicle company shall not charge more than [nine] TWELVE
5 dollars per full or partial twenty-four hour rental day for optional
6 vehicle protection if the manufacturer's suggested retail price of the
7 rental vehicle is not greater than thirty thousand dollars. A rental
8 vehicle company shall not charge more than [twelve] FIFTEEN dollars per
9 full or partial twenty-four hour rental day for optional vehicle
10 protection if the manufacturer's suggested retail price of the rental
11 vehicle is greater than thirty thousand dollars.
12 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately; provided, however, that
13 the amendments to section 396-z of the general business law made by
14 section one of this act shall not affect the expiration and reversion of
15 such section and shall expire therewith.
