- AN ACT to amend the legislative law, in relation to state spending for fiscal years 2010-2011, 2011-2012 and 2012-2013

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 2 of section 54 of the legis-2 lative law, as added by chapter 1 of the laws of 2007, is amended to 3 read as follows:

4 (a) The legislature shall enact a budget for the upcoming fiscal year 5 that it determines is balanced in the general fund. THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF 6 ALL FUNDS SPENDING FOR EACH OF THE STATE FISCAL YEARS TWO THOUSAND TEN-7 -TWO THOUSAND ELEVEN, TWO THOUSAND ELEVEN--TWO THOUSAND TWELVE AND TWO 8 THOUSAND TWELVE--TWO THOUSAND THIRTEEN INDIVIDUALLY, WHICH SHALL INCLUDE 9 SPENDING FROM ALL STATE REVENUE SOURCES INCLUDING TAXES, FEES, FINES, FEDERAL GRANTS, BOND PROCEEDS, LOTTERY PROCEEDS AND MISCELLANEOUS 10 RECEIPTS, AND WHICH COMPRISES SPENDING FROM THE GENERAL FUND, 11 SPECIAL REVENUE FUNDS, CAPITAL PROJECTS FUND, DEBT 12 SERVICE FUNDS, INTERNAL 13 SERVICE FUNDS, ENTERPRISE FUNDS AND FIDUCIARY FUNDS, SHALL NOT EXCEED TOTAL SPENDING IN THE STATE FISCAL YEAR TWO THOUSAND NINE--TWO THOUSAND 14 15 TEN; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT SUCH SPENDING MAY EXCEED SUCH AMOUNT BY THE AMOUNT OF ANY UNEXPECTED FEDERAL FUNDS RECEIVED BY THE STATE. 16 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately. 17
