AN ACT relating to providing certain health insurance benefits to Yvonne  
D. Mosca upon her retirement

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-  
BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of state or local law  
2     to the contrary, Yvonne D. Mosca, a current tier 2 member of the New  
3     York state and local employees' retirement system, who was an employee  
4     of the city of Mount Vernon from 1975 until 1985, who was rehired by  
5     such city in 1995 and who was employed by the New York state legislature  
6     from 1985 until 1995, shall be entitled to receive full family coverage  
7     under the New York state health insurance program upon her retirement.  
8     One hundred percent of the costs of such coverage shall be borne by the  
9     city of Mount Vernon.

10    S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

FISCAL NOTE.--The health insurance coverage cost for Yvonne Mosca is  
as follows:
