AN ACT to amend the public officers law, in relation to state legislative ethics

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Section 73 of the public officers law is amended by adding
2 two new subdivisions 14-a and 14-b to read as follows:
3 14-A. NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF SUBDIVISION FOURTEEN OF THIS
4 SECTION, NO MEMBER OF THE LEGISLATURE OR LEGISLATIVE EMPLOYEE, AS
5 DEFINED BY PARAGRAPH (D) OF SUBDIVISION ONE OF SECTION SEVENTY-THREE-A
6 OF THIS ARTICLE, SHALL PARTICIPATE IN ANY DECISION TO HIRE, PROMOTE,
7 PROCESS EMPLOYMENT PAPERWORK FOR OR HAVE KNOWLEDGE OF THE PROSPECTIVE
8 EMPLOYMENT OR CHANGE OF EMPLOYMENT STATUS OF ANY RELATIVE FOR ANY
9 COMPENSATED POSITION AT, FOR OR WITHIN THE SAME LEGISLATIVE CHAMBER
10 WHICH EMPLOYS SUCH MEMBER OR LEGISLATIVE EMPLOYEE. THE PROVISIONS OF
11 THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL NOT APPLY TO PERSONS TO WHICH PARAGRAPH (B) OF
12 SUBDIVISION FOURTEEN OF THIS SECTION APPLIES.
13 14-B. IN ADDITION TO THE INFORMATION INCLUDED IN THE ANNUAL FINANCIAL
14 STATEMENT OF FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE PROVIDED FOR IN SECTION
15 SEVENTY-THREE-A OF THIS ARTICLE, EVERY MEMBER OF THE LEGISLATURE AND
16 LEGISLATIVE EMPLOYEE SHALL DISCLOSE THE NAMES OF ALL RELATIVES WHO ARE
17 EMPLOYED BY THE LEGISLATURE AND THE DEGREE OF THEIR RELATIONSHIP.
18 S 2. Paragraph d of subdivision 3 of section 74 of the public officers
19 law, as amended by chapter 1012 of the laws of 1965, is amended to read
20 as follows:
21 d. No officer or employee of a state agency, member of the legislature
22 or legislative employee should use or attempt to use his OR HER official
23 position to secure unwarranted privileges or exemptions for himself,
24 HERSELF, HIS OR HER RELATIVE, AS DEFINED IN PARAGRAPH (M) OF SUBDIVISION
25 ONE OF SECTION SEVENTY-THREE OF THIS ARTICLE, or others.
26 S 3. This act shall take effect January 1, 2010.
