AUBERTINE -- read twice and ordered printed, and when printed to be committed to the Committee on Rules -- recommitted to the Committee on Transportation in accordance with Senate Rule 6, sec. 8 -- reported favorably from said committee, ordered to first and second report, ordered to a third reading, passed by Senate and delivered to the Assembly, recalled, vote reconsidered, restored to third reading, amended and ordered reprinted, retaining its place in the order of third reading

AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to designating a portion of the state highway system in the city of Ogdensburg as the "Trooper Shawn W. Snow Street"

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 343-x to
2 read as follows:
3 S 343-X. PORTION OF THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM TO BE DESIGNATED AS THE
4 "TROOPER SHAWN W. SNOW STREET". ALL THAT PORTION OF THE STATE HIGHWAY
5 SYSTEM IN THE CITY OF OGDENSBURG CONSISTING OF STATE ROUTE EIGHT HUNDRED
6 TWELVE FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH STATE ROUTE THIRTY-SEVEN TO THE NORTH-
7 ERLY MOST INTERSECTION OF STATE ROUTE THIRTY-SEVEN AND STATE ROUTE EIGHT
8 HUNDRED TWELVE SHALL BE DESIGNATED AND KNOWN AS THE "TROOPER SHAWN W.
9 SNOW STREET".
10 S 2. The commissioner of transportation shall provide for the instal-
11 lation and maintenance of adequate signing of the state highway system
12 as designated pursuant to section one of this act; provided that, to
13 avoid any confusion and to limit any possible disruption of commerce,
14 the designation called for pursuant to section one of this act shall be
15 one of ceremonial nature and the official name of such highway shall not
16 be changed as a result of this act.
17 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
