AN ACT to amend the civil service law, in relation to the status of subsidized public sector employment program workers under the public employees' fair employment act

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision 7 of section 201 of the civil service law is amended by adding a new paragraph (h) to read as follows:

- (H) THE TERM "PUBLIC EMPLOYEE" SHALL BE DEEMED TO INCLUDE PARTICIPANTS IN SUBSIDIZED PUBLIC SECTOR EMPLOYMENT PROGRAMS. SUCH PARTICIPANTS SHALL BE TREATED AS MEMBERS OF THE APPROPRIATE BARGAINING UNIT OF THE EMPLOYEES OF THE SPONSOR OF THE PROGRAM, WHETHER A SOCIAL SERVICES DISTRICT OR THE DEPARTMENT OF FAMILY ASSISTANCE. THE STATE COMMISSION SHALL PROMULGATE RULES AND REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS PARAGRAPH AND RECONCILE THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION THREE HUNDRED THIRTY-SIX-E OF THE SOCIAL SERVICES LAW WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE.
- 11 S 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred twentieth day after 12 it shall have become a law; provided that the state civil service 13 commission is authorized to promulgate any and all rules and regulations 14 and take any other measures necessary to implement this act on its 15 effective date on or before such date.
