AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to forgery of a certificate of insurance or insurance identification card and criminal possession of a forged certificate of insurance or insurance identification card

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The penal law is amended by adding two new sections 170.17
2 and 170.19 to read as follows:
3 S 170.17 FORGERY OF A CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE OR INSURANCE IDENTIFICA-
4 TION CARD.
5 A PERSON IS GUILTY OF FORGERY OF A CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE OR INSUR-
6 ANCE IDENTIFICATION CARD WHEN, WITH INTENT TO DEFRAUD, DECEIVE OR INJURE
7 ANOTHER, HE OR SHE FALSELY MAKES, COMPLETES OR ALTERS A CERTIFICATE OF
8 INSURANCE, AS DEFINED IN SUBDIVISION FIVE OF SECTION THREE HUNDRED ELEV-
9 EN OF THE VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC LAW, OR AN INSURANCE IDENTIFICATION CARD,
10 AS DEFINED IN SUBDIVISION TEN OF SECTION THREE HUNDRED ELEVEN OF THE
11 VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC LAW.
12 FORGERY OF A CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE OR INSURANCE IDENTIFICATION CARD
13 IS A CLASS E FELONY.
14 S 170.19 CRIMINAL POSSESSION OF A FORGED CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE OR
15 INSURANCE IDENTIFICATION CARD.
16 A PERSON IS GUILTY OF CRIMINAL POSSESSION OF A FORGED CERTIFICATE OF
17 INSURANCE OR INSURANCE IDENTIFICATION CARD WHEN, WITH KNOWLEDGE THAT IT
18 IS FORGED AND WITH INTENT TO DEFRAUD, DECEIVE OR INJURE ANOTHER, HE OR
19 SHE UTTERS OR POSSESSES A FORGED INSTRUMENT THAT IS A CERTIFICATE OF
20 INSURANCE, AS DEFINED IN SUBDIVISION FIVE OF SECTION THREE HUNDRED ELEV-
21 EN OF THE VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC LAW, OR AN INSURANCE IDENTIFICATION CARD,
