AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to party emblems

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 4, paragraph (c) of subdivi-
2 sion 5 and subdivision 9 of section 7-104 of the election law, as
3 amended by chapter 654 of the laws of 1985, subdivision 9 as renumbered
4 by chapter 262 of the laws of 1986, are amended to read as follows:
5 (a) The [party emblem for each political party represented on the
6 machine, and the] party name or other designation, and a designating
7 letter and number shall be affixed to the name of each candidate, or, in
8 case of presidential electors, to the names of the candidates for presi-
9 dent and vice-president of such party.
10 (c) If such candidate has also been nominated by one or more independ-
11 ent bodies, his name shall appear only in each row or column containing
12 generally the names of candidates for other offices nominated by any
13 such party and the name [and emblem] of each such independent body shall
14 appear in one such row or column to be designated by the candidate in a
15 writing filed with the officer or board charged with the duty of provid-
16 ing ballots, or if such person shall fail to so designate, the names
17 [and emblems] of such independent bodies shall appear in such row or
18 column as such officer or board shall determine.
19 9. The [board of elections shall provide a card or printed slip to be
20 placed in the card holder which] BALLOT shall have printed upon it in
21 black ink for each party or independent row containing the names of
22 candidates, the image of a closed fist with index finger extended point-
23 ing to the party or independent row. Inset within the image of the fist
24 on a white space, in black letters as large as the space will permit,
25 shall be printed the name of the party or independent body and at the
26 right of the fist and below the index finger shall be printed in black
27 ink the emblem and the designating letters of the row or column.
28 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
