AN ACT to amend the public service law, in relation to the expiration of minutes purchased with prepaid cellular telephone cards

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Paragraphs e and f of subdivision 2 of section 92-f of the public service law, as added by chapter 651 of the laws of 1999, are amended and a new paragraph g is added to read as follows:
 - e. any expiration date or expiration policy; [and]
 - f. instructions for use of the card[.]; AND

- G. IN THE CASE OF A COMPANY THAT OFFERS PREPAID CELLULAR TELEPHONE SERVICES BY MEANS OF A PREPAID CALLING CARD, SUCH PREPAID CALLING CARD SHALL HAVE PRINTED ON ITS FACE, IN CONSPICUOUS PRINT OF A FONT AT LEAST TWO TIMES LARGER THAT ANY OTHER PRINT PRINTED ON SUCH CARD, THE EXPIRATION DATE FOR THE CELLULAR MINUTES PURCHASED WITH THE CARD.
- 11 S 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall 12 have become a law.
