AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to requiring a multi-cultural curriculum

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The education law is amended by adding a new section 804-e to read as follows:

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- S 804-E. MULTI-CULTURAL CURRICULUM. 1. ALL SCHOOLS INCLUDING ELEMENTA-RY SCHOOLS, JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOLS AND SENIOR HIGH SCHOOLS SHALL BE REQUIRED TO TEACH A MULTI-CULTURAL CURRICULUM WHICH SHALL BE SET OUT IN RULES AND REGULATIONS TO BE PROMULGATED BY THE COMMISSIONER.

IN FORMULATING THE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR A MULTI-CULTURAL CURRICULUM THECOMMISSIONER SHALL ALLOW FOR AND SHALL IMPLEMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS WHICH CONSIDER THE DIFFERENCES IN THE CULTURAL COMPOSI-9 10 TION OF EACH SCHOOL AND THE COMMISSIONER SHALL ALLOW AND DIRECT SCHOOLS 11 TO DO RESEARCH AND OBSERVATION ON THEIR OWN STUDENT BODY IN ORDER TO PARTICULARIZE MULTI-CULTURAL EDUCATION TO FIT SUCH EDUCATION TO SUCH 12 13 SCHOOL.
- 3. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL ALSO PROMULGATE RULES AND REGULATIONS WHICH SHALL SET OUT A TEACHER EDUCATION PROGRAM IN ORDER TO TRAIN TEACHERS AND EDUCATORS TO TEACH AND INTERACT WITH STUDENTS OF DIFFERENT CULTURAL AND ETHNIC BACKGROUNDS.
- 18 S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of September next 19 succeeding the date on which it shall have become a law.
