THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Legislative intent. The legislature hereby finds and declares that the enactment of these appropriations provides sufficient authority to the comptroller for the purpose of making payments for the purposes described herein until such time as appropriation bills submitted by the governor pursuant to article VII of the state constitution for the support of government for the state fiscal year beginning April 1, 2010 are enacted.

It is hereby declared to be the intent of 38 the legislature that this act would have been enacted even if such 39 invalid provisions had not been included herein.

This act shall take effect immediately and shall be deemed to have been in full force and effect on and after April 1, 2010; provided, however, that upon the transfer of expenditures and disbursements by the comptroller as provided in section thirteen of this act, the appropriations made by this act and subject to such section shall be deemed repealed.
