AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to allowing the use of rifles for hunting in Cortland county

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. Item (i) of paragraph a of subdivision 2 of section 11-0907  
2     of the environmental conservation law, as amended by chapter 441 of the  
3     laws of 2009, is amended to read as follows:
