AN ACT to authorize the county of Chautauqua to elect to participate in the medical assistance reimbursement option and revenue intercept for Medicaid purposes

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Notwithstanding the expiration of the opt in period, the  
2 county of Chautauqua may elect to participate in the medical assistance  
3 reimbursement option and revenue intercept for Medicaid purposes as set  
4 forth in part C of chapter 58 of the laws of 2005, as amended, if such  
5 county shall adopt a resolution in the form described in section 2 of  
6 such part, on or before December 31, 2010, and shall comply with all  
7 other applicable provisions of such program. The commissioner of health  
8 is hereby authorized to accept a duly adopted resolution by the county  
9 of Chautauqua to participate in the reimbursement program and to certify  
10 such participation to the commissioner of taxation and finance. The  
11 applicable sales tax rate shall be established as of January 1, 2011;  
12 provided that only the portion of sales taxes attributable to the county  
13 shall be included. Amounts attributable to municipalities within the  
14 county shall be excluded and municipalities shall continue to receive  
15 such portion of the sales tax revenue which are collected on their  
16 behalf.

17 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
