AN ACT to amend the workers' compensation law, in relation to recording of investigation transcripts

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 122 of the workers' compensation law, as amended by
2 chapter 113 of the laws of 1946, is amended to read as follows:
3 S 122. Transcripts. A copy of the testimony, evidence and procedure of
4 any investigation, or a particular part thereof, RECORDED AND tran-
5 scribed by a stenographer in the employ of the board and certified by
6 such stenographer to be true and correct may be received in evidence
7 with the same effect as if such stenographer were present and testifying
8 to the facts so certified. A copy of such transcript shall be furnished
9 to any party upon payment of the fee for transcripts of similar minutes
10 in the supreme court.
11 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
