AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to certified home health agencies

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 3608 of the public health law is amended by adding 2 a new subdivision 7 to read as follows:

- 3 7. A CERTIFIED HOME HEALTH AGENCY IN OPERATION AS OF THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SUBDIVISION AND ISSUED A CERTIFICATE OF APPROVAL BY COMMISSIONER FOR THE PURPOSE OF SERVING INDIVIDUALS ELIGIBLE FOR CARE IN 6 A FACILITY OR PROGRAM LICENSED BY THE OFFICE OF MENTAL HEALTH OR THE 7 OFFICE OF MENTAL RETARDATION AND DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES OR AS A SPECIAL PILOT PROGRAM HOME HEALTH AGENCY IS AUTHORIZED BY VIRTUE OF SUCH 9 CERTIFICATE TO ENROLL ANY PATIENT DETERMINED TO REQUIRE CERTIFIED HOME 10 HEALTH AGENCY SERVICES; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT SUCH AGENCY POSSESSES DEMONSTRATED CLINICAL EXPERTISE IN THE TREATMENT OF THE POPU-11 LATION SPECIFIED IN ITS CERTIFICATE OF APPROVAL, (B) CONTINUES TO 12 MARKET, ACCEPT FOR ENROLLMENT AND TREAT MEMBERS OF SUCH POPULATION, AND 13 (C) ENTERS INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE COMMISSIONER THAT DURING THE PERI-14 OD JANUARY FIRST, TWO THOUSAND ELEVEN THROUGH DECEMBER THIRTY-FIRST, TWO 15 THOUSAND ELEVEN AND FOR EACH CALENDAR YEAR PERIOD COMMENCING ON JANUARY 16 FIRST THEREAFTER, RATES OF PAYMENT BY GOVERNMENTAL AGENCIES ESTABLISHED 17 BY THE COMMISSIONER IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE RATE-SETTING METHODOLOGY THEN 18 19 IN EFFECT FOR SERVICES BY SUCH CERTIFIED HOME HEALTH AGENCY TO 20 UALS ELIGIBLE FOR MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PURSUANT TO TITLE ELEVEN OF ARTICLE SOCIAL SERVICES LAW SHALL NOT EXCEED THE AVERAGE OF SUCH 21 FIVE OF THE22 RATES OF PAYMENT FOR CERTIFIED HOME HEALTH AGENCIES CLASSIFIED DOWNSTATE REGION, AS DEFINED BY REGULATIONS PROMULGATED PURSUANT TO 23 SECTION THIRTY-SIX HUNDRED TWELVE OF THIS ARTICLE OR SUCCESSOR LEGIS-24 25 LATION.
- 26 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
