AN ACT to amend the agriculture and markets law, in relation to vaccination of egg-laying hens against salmonella

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The agriculture and markets law is amended by adding a new 2 section 96-z-30 to read as follows:

3 S 96-Z-30. VACCINATION OF EGG-LAYING POULTRY AGAINST SALMONELLA ENTER-4 ITIDIS. 1. NO PERSON, CORPORATION, OR OTHER ENTITY SHALL TRANSPORT, 5 SELL, OFFER OR EXPOSE FOR SALE WITHIN THE STATE EGGS FOR THE PURPOSE OF 6 HUMAN CONSUMPTION UNLESS SUCH EGGS ORIGINATE FROM POULTRY THAT HAS BEEN 7 VACCINATED AGAINST SALMONELLA ENTERITIDIS.

8 2. NOTWITHSTANDING SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS SECTION, EGGS THAT DO NOT 9 ORIGINATE FROM POULTRY THAT HAS BEEN VACCINATED AGAINST SALMONELLA 10 ENTERITIDIS MAY, WITH THE WRITTEN PERMISSION OF THE COMMISSIONER OR THE 11 COMMISSIONER'S DESIGNEE, BE TRANSPORTED WITHIN THE STATE AN TΟ EGG-BREAKING PLANT FOR PASTEURIZATION. 12

NOTWITHSTANDING SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS SECTION, EGGS THAT DO NOT
 ORIGINATE FROM POULTRY THAT HAS BEEN VACCINATED AGAINST SALMONELLA
 ENTERITIDIS MAY, WITH THE WRITTEN PERMISSION OF THE COMMISSIONER OR THE
 COMMISSIONER'S DESIGNEE, BE TRANSPORTED AND POSSESSED WITHIN THE STATE
 FOR USE IN RESEARCH OR EXPERIMENTATION.

18 4. VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION SHALL CONSTITUTE A CLASS A MISDEMEANOR.

19 5. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL PROMULGATE AND ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS 20 TO GIVE FULL EFFECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.

S 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after it shall have become a law; provided, however, that effective immediately, the addition, amendment, or repeal of any rule or regulation necessary for the implementation of this act on its effective date is authorized and directed to be made and completed on or before such effective date.
