AN ACT to amend the insurance law, in relation to annual physicals and well care visits

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subsection (i) of section 3216 of the insurance law is 2 amended by adding a new paragraph 27 to read as follows:

- (27) EVERY INDIVIDUAL POLICY WHICH PROVIDES MEDICAL, MAJOR MEDICAL OR SIMILAR COMPREHENSIVE-TYPE COVERAGE THAT INCLUDES COVERAGE FOR A PHYS-ICAL OR WELL CARE VISIT ONCE IN EVERY THREE HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE DAYS SHALL BE INTERPRETED TO MEAN THAT SUCH PHYSICAL OR WELL CARE VISIT HAD ONCE EVERY CALENDAR YEAR, REGARDLESS OF WHETHER OR NOT A PERIOD OF THREE HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE DAYS HAS PASSED SINCE THE PREVIOUS OR WELL CARE VISIT.
- 10 S 2. Subsection (k) of section 3221 of the insurance law is amended by 11 adding a new paragraph 16 to read as follows:
- EVERY GROUP OR BLANKET POLICY WHICH PROVIDES MEDICAL, MAJOR MEDICAL OR SIMILAR COMPREHENSIVE-TYPE COVERAGE THAT INCLUDES COVERAGE FOR A PHYSICAL OR WELL CARE VISIT ONCE IN EVERY THREE HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE SHALL BE INTERPRETED TO MEAN THAT SUCH PHYSICAL OR WELL CARE VISIT CAN BE HAD ONCE EVERY CALENDAR YEAR, REGARDLESS OF WHETHER OR NOT A 17 THREE HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE DAYS HAS PASSED SINCE THE PREVIOUS PHYSICAL OR WELL CARE VISIT.
- 19 S 3. Section 4303 of the insurance law is amended by adding a new 20 subsection (gg) to read as follows:
 - (GG) EVERY CONTRACT ISSUED BY A CORPORATION SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE WHICH PROVIDES MEDICAL, MAJOR MEDICAL OR SIMILAR COMPRE-HENSIVE-TYPE COVERAGE THAT INCLUDES COVERAGE FOR A PHYSICAL OR WELL CARE VISIT ONCE IN EVERY THREE HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE DAYS SHALL BE INTERPRETED THAT SUCH PHYSICAL OR WELL CARE VISIT CAN BE HAD ONCE EVERY MEAN CALENDAR YEAR, REGARDLESS OF WHETHER OR NOT A PERIOD OF THREE SIXTY-FIVE DAYS HAS PASSED SINCE THE PREVIOUS PHYSICAL OR WELL CARE VISIT.
- S 4. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it 29 30 have become a law and shall apply to policies and contracts issued, 31 renewed, modified, altered or amended on or after such date.
