AN ACT making appropriations for the support of government

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Legislative intent. The legislature hereby finds and 2 declares that the enactment of these appropriations provides sufficient 3 authority to the comptroller for the purpose of making payments for the 4 purposes described herein until such time as appropriation bills submit-5 ted by the governor pursuant to article VII of the state constitution for the support of government for the state fiscal year beginning April 6 7 1, 2010 are enacted.

The sum of three hundred seventy-six million eight hundred 9 fifty-two thousand dollars (\$376,852,000), or so much thereof as shall 10 be sufficient to accomplish the purpose designated, is hereby appropri-11 ated and authorized to be paid as hereinafter provided, to the public 12 officers and for the purposes specified, which amount shall be available 13 for the state fiscal year beginning April 1, 2010.
