Introduced by M. of A. CASTRO -- read once and referred to the Committee on Education

AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to assisting the parents of children who disrupt the education process, in efforts to curtail such misbehavior

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 2 of section 3212 of the education law is  
2 amended by adding a new paragraph f to read as follows:  
3 F. SHALL, IN THE CASE OF AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS BEEN DISCIPLINED FOR  
4 REPEATED DISRUPTIVE ACTIVITY, VIOLENT ACTS AND/OR A WEAPONS-RELATED  
5 OFFENSE, WHEN DIRECTED BY ANY COURT HAVING JURISDICTION AS PROVIDED IN  
6 SECTION THREE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED THIRTY-TWO OF THIS PART AND/OR  
7 REQUESTED BY THE SCHOOL DISTRICT WHERE SUCH INDIVIDUAL ATTENDS UPON  
8 INSTRUCTION, PARTICIPATE IN AN APPROPRIATE PARENTING SUPPORT, COUNSELING  
9 OR EDUCATION PROGRAM, AND/OR IN COMMUNITY SERVICE WITH SUCH INDIVIDUAL.  
10 WHERE SUCH PERSONS IN PARENTAL RELATION REQUIRE LEAVE FROM WORK TO HELP  
11 SCHOOLS CORRECT DISRUPTIVE BEHAVIOR IN THE INDIVIDUALS ENTRUSTED TO  
12 THEIR CHARGE AND CARE, TO ATTEND AND PARTICIPATE IN SUCH PARENTING  
13 SUPPORT, COUNSELING, OR EDUCATION PROGRAMS AND/OR TO PARTICIPATE IN SUCH  
14 COMMUNITY SERVICE, THE EMPLOYERS OF SUCH PERSONS IN PARENTAL RELATION  
15 SHALL PROVIDE SUCH PERSONS WITH UP TO THREE DAYS PER YEAR OF PAID JOB  
16 LEAVE FOR THESE PURPOSES.  
17 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
