AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to set
back requirements from wetlands and notice requirements to future
owners or lessees

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-
BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 2 of section 24-0701 of the environmental
2 conservation law, as amended by chapter 654 of the laws of 1977, is
3 amended to read as follows:
4 2. Activities subject to regulation shall include any form of drain-
5 ing, dredging, excavation, removal of soil, mud, sand, shells, gravel or
6 other aggregate from any freshwater wetland, either directly or indi-
7 rectly; and any form of dumping, filling, or depositing of any soil,
8 stones, sand, gravel, mud, rubbish or fill of any kind, either directly
9 or indirectly; erecting any structures, roads, the driving of pilings,
10 or placing of any other obstructions whether or not changing the ebb and
11 flow of the water; any form of pollution, including but not limited to,
12 installing a septic tank, running a sewer outfall, discharging sewage
13 treatment effluent or other liquid wastes into or so as to drain into a
14 freshwater wetland; and any other activity which substantially impairs
15 any of the several functions served by freshwater wetlands or the bene-
16 fits derived therefrom which are set forth in section 24-0105 of this
17 article. These activities are subject to regulation whether or not they
18 occur upon the wetland itself, if they impinge upon or otherwise
19 substantially affect the wetlands and are located not more than one
20 hundred feet from the boundary of such wetland. ALL PROPERTIES LOCATED
21 WITHIN ONE HUNDRED FEET OF THE BOUNDARY OF A DESIGNATED WETLAND SHALL
22 MAINTAIN A SET BACK OF TEN FEET FROM SUCH WETLAND. THE TEN FOOT SET BACK
23 SHALL BE REQUIRED TO BE MAINTAINED IN ITS NATURAL STATE. ADDITIONALLY,
24 ANY POTENTIAL NEW HOMEOWNERS OR RENTERS OF PROPERTY LOCATED ONE HUNDRED
25 FEET FROM THE BOUNDARY OF A WETLAND UPON WHICH THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVI-
26 RONMENTAL CONSERVATION PLACES RESTRICTIONS OF ANY SORT MUST BE NOTIFIED
27 IN WRITING OF SUCH RESTRICTIONS BY THE LANDOWNER BEFORE A DEED IS TRANS-

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1 FERRED OR A LEASE IS SIGNED. Provided, that FURTHER, a greater distance
2 from any such wetland may be regulated pursuant to this article by the
3 appropriate local government or by the department, whichever has juris-
4 diction over such wetland, where necessary to protect and preserve the
5 wetland.
6 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
