AN ACT to amend the criminal procedure law, in relation to issuance of an arrest warrant for a person charged with a traffic misdemeanor

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 120.20 of the criminal procedure
2 law, as amended by chapter 506 of the laws of 2000, is amended to read
3 as follows:
4 1. When a criminal action has been commenced in a local criminal court
5 by the filing therewith of an accusatory instrument, other than a
6 simplified traffic information ALLEGING ONLY A TRAFFIC INFRACTION,
7 against a defendant who has not been arraigned upon such accusatory
8 instrument and has not come under the control of the court with respect
9 thereto:
10 (a) such court may, if such accusatory instrument is sufficient on its
11 face, issue a warrant for such defendant's arrest; or
12 (b) if such accusatory instrument is not sufficient on its face as
13 prescribed in section 100.40, and if the court is satisfied that on the
14 basis of the available facts or evidence it would be impossible to draw
15 and file an accusatory instrument that is sufficient on its face, the
16 court must dismiss the accusatory instrument.
17 S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of January next succeed-
18 ing the date on which it shall have become a law.
