AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to allowing the use of rifles for hunting in Wyoming county; and providing for the repeal of such provisions upon expiration thereof

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Item (i) of paragraph a of subdivision 2 of section 11-0907 of the environmental conservation law, as amended by chapter 441 of the laws of 2009, is amended to read as follows:
- (i) The counties of 4 Deer, the first Monday Pistol, shotgun, 5 after November 15 muzzle loading Allegany, 6 Cattaraugus, Chemung, through first Tuesday firearm, after December 7 7 Chenango, Herkimer, rifle or 8 long bow only Madison,
- 9 Montgomery, Oneida,
- 10 Oswego, Otsego,
- 11 Schoharie, Schuyler,
- 12 Steuben,
- 13 Tioga, WYOMING and Yates
- 14 and that portion of
- 15 the county of
- 16 Broome east of the
- 17 Susquehanna river
- 18 S 2. Item (i) of paragraph a of subdivision 2 of section 11-0907 of
- 19 the environmental conservation law, as added by section 2 of chapter 600

- Pistol, shotgun, 21 (i) The counties of Deer and bear, the 22 Allegany, first Monday after muzzle loading 23 Cattaraugus, November 15 through firearm, rifle or 24 Chenango, Herkimer, first Tuesday after long bow only
