AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to limited permits in dentistry

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 6605 of the education law is amended by adding a  
2 new subdivision 6 to read as follows:  
3 6. NOTWITHSTANDING SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS SECTION, DENTAL SCHOOL  
4 GRADUATES SHALL BE DEEMED TO BE EXEMPT PERSONS PURSUANT TO SECTION  
5 SIXTY-SIX HUNDRED TEN OF THIS ARTICLE AND SHALL NOT BE REQUIRED TO  
6 OBTAIN A LIMITED PERMIT IF THEY ARE EMPLOYED IN AN APPROVED RESIDENCY  
7 PROGRAM FOR THE PURPOSE OF FULFILLING INITIAL LICENSURE REQUIREMENTS  
8 PURSUANT TO SECTION SIXTY-SIX HUNDRED TWO OF THIS ARTICLE. THE DEPART-  
9 MENT MAY CHARGE SUCH RESIDENTS A REASONABLE RESIDENCY REGISTRATION FEE  
10 WHICH SHALL NOT EXCEED THE LIMITED PERMIT FEE SPECIFIED IN SUBDIVISION  
11 FOUR OF THIS SECTION. THE PAYMENT OF ANY RESIDENCY REGISTRATION FEE  
12 SHALL NOT BE A PRECONDITION TO ENTERING A RESIDENCY PROGRAM, BUT PAYMENT  
13 MAY BE REQUIRED AT ANY OTHER REASONABLE TIME ESTABLISHED BY THE DEPART-  
14 MENT.  
15 S 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after  
16 it shall have become a law.
