AN ACT to amend the real property tax law, in relation to providing tax receipts electronically

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 955 of the real property tax law is amended by 2 adding a new subdivision 3-a to read as follows:

3 THE COLLECTING OFFICER SHALL DELIVER OR MAIL THE RECEIPT 3-A. (A) 4 REOUIRED UNDER SUBDIVISION THREE OF THIS SECTION UNLESS A TAXPAYER 5 TO RECEIVE SUCH RECEIPT ELECTRONICALLY, REOUESTS IN WHICH CASE THE COLLECTING OFFICER SHALL MAKE AN ELECTRONIC RECEIPT 6 AVAILABLE TO THE 7 THE COLLECTING OFFICER SHALL NOTIFY ALL TAXPAYERS THAT ANY TAXPAYER. 8 AVAILABILITY OF ELECTRONIC RECEIPTS DOES NOT PRECLUDE А TAXPAYER FROM 9 ELECTING TO RECEIVE A COPY OF HIS OR HER TAX RECEIPT IN THE MAIL OR IN 10 PERSON.

11 (B) THE PROVISIONS OF PARAGRAPH (A) OF THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL APPLY 12 ONLY TO A CITY, TOWN, OR VILLAGE WHICH BY LOCAL LAW PROVIDES THAT ELEC-13 TRONIC AVAILABILITY OF SUCH RECEIPTS SHALL BE AN AUTHORIZED MEANS OF 14 DELIVERY.

15 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
