AN ACT to amend the alcoholic beverage control law, in relation to
authorizing peace officers to work in licensed premises in certain
cases and exempting such persons from background checks

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-
BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The alcoholic beverage control law is amended by adding a
2 new section 128-b to read as follows:
3 S 128-B. CERTAIN PEACE OFFICERS ALLOWED TO WORK IN LICENSED PREMISES
4 IN CERTAIN CASES. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY INCONSISTENT PROVISION OF LAW TO
5 THE CONTRARY, A PEACE OFFICER AS DESIGNATED IN SUBDIVISIONS ONE, TWO,
6 TWENTY-THREE OR TWENTY-FIVE OF SECTION 2.10 OF THE CRIMINAL PROCEDURE
7 LAW AND EMPLOYED IN THIS STATE, HAVING WRITTEN PERMISSION AND CONSENT
8 FROM HIS OR HER COMMANDING OFFICER, MAY WORK AS A SECURITY GUARD OR
9 DIRECTOR OF TRAFFIC ON THE PREMISES OF ANY ORGANIZATION LICENSED UNDER
10 THE PROVISIONS OF THIS CHAPTER TO SELL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AT RETAIL FOR
11 ON-PREMISES CONSUMPTION. SUCH PEACE OFFICERS SHALL BE EXEMPT FROM ANY
12 PROVISIONS OF THIS CHAPTER REQUIRING THE FINGERPRINTING OR OTHER
13 REQUIREMENTS OF BACKGROUND CHECKS.
14 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
